CMI Level 3 Diploma in First Line Management

These programmes build upon the past operational knowledge and experience of managers by focussing on the more strategic issues of management within an organisation.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This is a course designed for people new to a supervisory or line management role, or for those with significant experience but no formal management qualifications. It is a broad based course covering all aspects of the management role and content is directly related to learners own workplaces and previous experience.

MODULES

Choose six modules from the following, a minimum of 37 credits is required to achieve the certificate;

- Personal development as a first line manager (6 credits)
- Identifying development opportunities (6 credits)
- Resource planning (6 credits)
- Meeting stakeholder needs (6 credits)
- Managing and communicating information (6 credits)
- Improving team performance (7 credits)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

No formal entry requirements.

DELIVERY INFORMATION

One taught session per week, Tuesdays 18.00-21.00, culminating in a formal written or typed assesment for each module. In addition 3 hours per week personal study will be required.
