ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants will normally have achieved a HND/Foundation Degree in Business and/or Management. Other equivalent level 5 qualifications in Business and/or Management (including international equivalents) and non-business qualifications such as HND in Computing, HND in Leisure and Tourism are also considered.

Applicants whose first language is not English must be able to demonstrate proficiency in the English language at a minimum level of CEFR level B2/IELTS Level 6 (reading and writing must be at level 6) or TOEFL score of 550 or equivalent standards.

DELIVERY INFORMATION

We aim to deliver a stimulating and challenging programme of study that is both engaging and memorable for our students. Our small class sizes allow for; innovative delivery, targeted personal support and regular one-to-one tutorials.

METHODS OF ASSESSMENT
