CILEx Graduate Fast Track Diploma

The CILEx Graduate Fast-track Diploma is for law and Graduate Diploma in Law (GDL) graduates who want to qualify as lawyers without undertaking the more traditional and expensive Legal Practice Course (LPC) or Bar Professional Training Course (BPTC) routes.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Part-time course available to those wanting to train as a Legal Executive. This is available to students who already have an LLB (qualifying law degree) and provides coverage of professional skills and practice units. Students will study two practical units (Civil Litigation and Conveyancing) and Client Care Skills (3 units in total).

MODULES

- Client Care Skills

Requires the preparation of a portfolio of tasks relevant to client care, from preparing attendance notes to further correspondence.

- Conveyancing

An in depth exploration of the background to the conveyancing process in relation to freehold and leasehold residential transactions.

- Civil Litigation

An in depth exploration of the processes and rules governing civil litigation.
