Which course is right for me?

We have courses to suit everyone - full-time or part-time, from degrees, HNDs and HNCs to Access to Higher Education courses, professional qualifications and apprenticeships. Discover more about your options and what they all mean.



Access to Higher Education

Access courses are one year full-time, or two year part-time courses designed for adults over the age of 19 who would like to return to education. There are no formal entry requirements; however, you may be asked to complete an online test to assess your suitability for the course.

BA (Hons) Degree

Honours degrees are recognised across the UK and Europe. An honours degree is awarded in one of four classes. HoW College is proud to offer full degrees in the following areas: social work and business.

BA (Hons) Top Up

Top up qualifications will convert your HND or Foundation Degree qualification to a full honours degree.

Higher National Certificate (HNC) & Higher National Diploma (HND)

Providing a combination of theory and practice, these qualifications are geared towards giving you the practical and technical skills for a particular field of work. You will be assessed through assignments and practical tasks. HNDs are qualifications in their own right, but you also have the option to convert them to a full honours degree by completing a final top-up with ourselves or at a university.

Professional Qualifications

These qualifications are awarded by professional bodies within their industry. Most are chartered and all are recognised by organisations within their field. Some careers will require you to be a member of a professional body, these include accountancy and law. A professional qualification will support you to develop your future career.

Foundation Degrees

Our foundation degrees are equivalent to the first two years of an honours degree and combine academic study with practical training for specific careers. They focus on developing the technical skills you need for work. You will be assessed through a variety of measures, including exams and practical work. Foundation degrees are gualifications in their own right, but you also have the option to convert them to a full honours degree by completing a final top-up year with ourselves or at one of our university partners.

Higher Apprenticeships

Higher apprenticeships are an alternative route to professions that have traditionally been reserved for graduates. They are recognised qualifications that incorporate work-based learning programmes.

Professional Qualifications

Professional qualifications will equip you with the knowledge and skills you need to boost your career. These qualifications are awarded by professional bodies and all are recognised by organisations within their industries.

Let's Talk Finance

How can I pay my course fees?

At HEI Worcestershire we are proud to be able to offer competitive tuition fees for both full-time and part-time study. This ensures you get the best value for money whilst guaranteeing you are receiving the same standard of education you would expect from a traditional university. There are a variety of options available to help pay for higher education course fees: student loans are available from Student Finance England for both full-time and part-time students. Alternatively, if you are not applying for a loan for your HE course or wish to pay in instalments for a professional course, arrangements can be made with our finance department during enrolment.

Is there any financial support?

Yes, we have access to a variety of support funds to help learners continue to study a higher education qualification with us, such as the Higher Education Access to Learning Fund and Advanced Learning Loans. Full-time higher education students can apply for a maintenance loan via the Student Loans Company.

What is the Higher Education Access to Learning Fund?

The Higher Education Access to Learning Fund is a fund to assist students during their higher education studies. Applications are available from the College's customer services team. This funding is not available to students studying with us on a franchised, sponsored basis and students must have applied for funding via Student Finance England.

How much are tuition fees at Heart of Worcestershire College?

Tuition fees for full-time, higher education courses are typically £8,000. For some courses they may be higher. For parttime, higher education courses fees are typically £4,000 per year. For more information, please visit howcollege.ac.uk

Can my employer pay for my higher education or professional course?

Yes, a letter from your employer/company confirming their intention to support your fees would be required at the time of enrolment. An invoice will be issued and payment can be made by cheque or BACS. Cheques should be made payable to Heart of Worcestershire College. The boost awards will be awarded based on the following criteria. Students must meet one or more of these to apply:

- Studying on a Heart of Worcestershire College validated higher education course
- Normally residing in England
- Have a household income of less than £25,000
- Self funding, not sponsored by an employer, the NHS or the training and development agency for schools
