# Can I pay my fees in instalments?

Yes you can! However, an initial payment is required at the time of enrolment to secure your place on your chosen course. This payment will be a third of your course fees and the remaining balance will then be split over future instalments. For more information, please call our finance team on 01905 743 573 or 01905 725 707.

# What are Advanced Learner Loans (ALL)?

Students who are studying a further education course (including some professional courses) at Level 3 or above and are over the age of 19, could be offered loans to cover the cost of their tuition fees on certain courses.

# How does my employer pay for my course fee?

A letter from your company/ employer confirming their intention to support your fees would be required at the time of enrolment. An invoice will be issued and payment can be made by cheque, card or BACS. Cheques should be made payable to Heart of Worcestershire College.

# Do you provide discounts for Jobseekers' Allowance?

A number of our courses offer a discount for those who are unemployed and on active benefits. If you are claiming discounted fees you must enrol in person and bring evidence of your eligibility.

# Can I get a refund for my course fees?

Refunds of tuition fees will only be given in the following circumstances: when the College cancels a course or when a learner withdraws from a course before the first meeting date (although an administration fee will be chargeable). All other requests for fee refunds will be at the discretion of the Principal and will only be considered in exceptional circumstances.

# How can I pay my course fees?

You can pay your course fees by cash, cheque, debit/credit card or direct debit. All cheques need to be made payable to Heart of Worcestershire College.

# Is there any financial support available for students studying a higher education course?

Yes, there are a number of bursaries available for students studying a higher education course. We have a Higher Education Access to Learning Fund and we also offer a BOOST award. Eligibility criteria is available on the College website. There are also government funded loans available to cover the cost of some courses.






