TYPES OF COURSES

Entry level, access, vocational courses... What does it all mean?

Sometimes applying for college can feel overwhelming, especially when you are being bombarded with jargon and fancy course names. We want to make applying for college as straightforward and stress-free as possible. Banish the taboo around which qualification is right for you with this quick and easy breakdown.

ENTRY LEVEL

If you don't have any formal qualifications then entry level courses could be the right choice for you. There are no entry requirements, just an interview and assessment to make sure you're on the right course. We offer entry level courses in a range of different subjects from construction to hair and beauty.

APPRENTICESHIPS

If earning whilst you're learning sounds good to you, why not explore the apprenticeship pathway? Your time will be split between college work and the workplace; helping you to develop invaluable skills, whilst putting them into practice and gaining qualifications. As a college we have a dedicated team, Solutions, who will support you through your apprenticeship journey from start to finish.

VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL COURSES

Vocational and technical courses teach you the skills and knowledge needed for a particular career. These courses are more practical than A-levels and will often see you studying in a working environment. Choosing the vocational/technical route will give you qualifications recognised by employers. Successful completion of a level 3 course will also give you the opportunity to progress onto higher education at college or university.

ACCESS

Access programmes are designed to prepare learners for entry into higher education. These programmes provide the knowledge and skills needed to progress onto a level 4 qualification at university or college. Access courses support learners who may be lacking in confidence, formal educational backgrounds and who have other commitments, to succeed in higher education. Learners must be over the age of 18 to qualify for these courses.

HIGHER EDUCATION

It's never too early to think about your next step. We offer a wide range of university level courses with competitive tuition fees. Our courses are still validated by universities meaning you will still receive the same qualification as if you had gone to a university. In addition, we have the advantage of providing individual support due to our small class sizes. Take a look at our higher education prospectus for more information.

YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

I DIDN'T GET MY GRADE 4 (C) IN ENGLISH AND MATHS AT GCSE. DOES THAT MEAN I CAN'T COME TO COLLEGE?

Not at all, students that have already achieved a grade 3 (D) at GCSE will be enrolled onto our GCSE programme. Those who haven't achieved a grade 3 or above will study Functional Skills alongside their course. Our supportive and talented Tutors will help students prepare for these qualifications, ensuring they achieve their full potential.

WILL I BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SOURCING MY OWN WORK EXPERIENCE?

Our proactive Work Experience Co-ordinators will help you find a work placement. We will support students every step of the way and aim to source each student with a meaningful and beneficial placement.

DO I HAVE TO GO TO ALL OF MY LESSONS?

At college you take responsibility for your own learning. However, we expect our students to abide by the College Values and Student Standards policy at all times. We expect students to make good decisions regarding their use of time, attendance and punctuality; failure to comply with college policies will result in disciplinary action.

IS THERE ANYONE I CAN TALK TO IF I'M HAVING PERSONAL PROBLEMS?

HoW College takes students' welfare extremely seriously. If you feel worried at college we have a dedicated welfare team on-site that you can talk to.

IF I STUDY A VOCATIONAL COURSE DOES THIS MEAN I CAN'T GO TO UNIVERSITY?

Definitely not, a level 3 course is equivalent to studying A-levels, this means you can still go onto university or higher education in the future.

WHAT ARE T-LEVELS?

T-Levels are new ‘Technical Level’ courses which will follow GCSEs and will be equivalent to 3 A-levels. These two-year courses have been developed in collaboration with employers and businesses so that the content meets the needs of industry and prepares students for work.

T-Levels will offer students a mixture of classroom learning and ‘on-the-job’ experience during an industry placement of at least 315 hours (approximately 45 days). They will provide the knowledge and experience needed to open the door into skilled employment, further study or a higher apprenticeship.

WHEN WILL THEY BEGIN?

You'll start to hear a lot about T-Levels as delivery begins from September 2020. However, HoW College will be delivering specific T-Levels from September 21/22.

HOW ARE T-LEVELS BEING DEVELOPED?

Employers and providers are working together to develop each T-Level, with support from Department for Education (DfE) and the Institute. Groups of employers define the skills and requirements for each T-Level course by participating in T-Level panels. This ensures that students taking T-Levels will develop the technical knowledge and skills required by employers in that industry.

WHAT T-LEVELS WILL BE OFFERED AT HoW COLLEGE?

As of September 21/22 HoW College will offer T-Levels in:

- Digital
- Childcare and Education

WILL T-LEVELS ALLOW ME TO PROGRESS TO UNIVERSITY?

T-Levels will provide several progression options to students. These include skilled employment, an apprenticeship and higher education.

To help T-Level students get into higher education, UCAS tariff points will be allocated to T-Levels.

UCAS points will only be allocated to the overall T-Level grade. Students must achieve at least an overall pass grade to receive UCAS points.

IMPROVING YOUR DIGITAL SKILLS

Here at HoW we understand how important it is to be employer ready and prepared for future study.

It is predicted that within 20 years, 90% of all jobs will require digital skills. It is also clear that you will need to learn new skills throughout your career. For these reasons we place an emphasis on developing independent and collaborative digital skills.

Every level 2 and level 3 programme has mandatory online learning built into the study programme. This is called blended learning.

Each week you will work through activities online such as quizzes, interactive videos and forums that will then be discussed in class.

There is lots of support in college to help you with your digital skills. Our learning centres are a hub for finding out information and we have fantastic IT facilities and study areas.


