



Many of you may have heard about 'Everyone's Invited' website detailing sexual harassment experienced by students predominantly at private schools but also at state funded schools and Colleges. In response to this, the Government has asked Ofsted to review safeguarding polices and guidance around sexual harassment. The Government has also set up a dedicated NSPCC helpline. The free helpline is for victims of abuse as well as parents and professionals seeking support. It will provide information about how to contact the police and report crimes, as well as help and advice to callers. **The helpline went live on 1 April 2021.
