Certificate in Education and Training

This course is designed for those new to teaching in all areas of the lifelong learning sector.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This is a 36 credit course at level 4 with a focus on practical teaching. It is appropriate for teachers, tutors, trainers, lecturers and instructors who may be working within an FE college, Adult and Community Learning and for those delivering work based learning such as within voluntary, community, private and public organisations. The Certificate gives the candidate the underpinning knowledge, understanding and skills needed to confirm occupational competence. This includes the planning and delivering of schemes of work and sessions, negotiation of individual goals, different teaching and learning strategies, communication issues and exploring a range of assessment practices. Teaching practice of at least 30 hours is a requirement of the qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Trainees will need to have a reasonable level of maths and English language (ideally level 2 in both). Trainees will also need at least a level 3 qualification in the subject they intend to teach. They will also need to have a minimum of 30 hours of teaching over the life of the course. The teaching can include small groups and one to one sessions and may be paid or voluntary. The trainee will also need a mentor who has experience in teaching their specialist subject. Trainees should not have a criminal background which might prevent them from working as a teacher with young people or vulnerable adults.
