Diploma in Education and Training

Are you a new teacher who would like to gain a full qualification to teach in the lifelong learning sector? Or have you completed the award or certificate and would like to progress and develop your career further?

COURSE OVERVIEW

This is a 120 credit course at level 5. It is appropriate for teachers, tutors, trainers, lecturers and instructors who may be working within an FE college, Adult and Community Learning and for those delivering work based learning such as within voluntary, community, private and public organisations. The diploma gives the candidate the underpinning knowledge, understanding and skills needed to confirm occupational competence. This includes the planning and delivering of schemes of work and sessions, negotiation of individual goals, different teaching and learning strategies, communication issues and exploring a range of assessment practices. Teaching practice of at least 100 hours is a requirement of the qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Trainees will need to have a reasonable level of maths and English language (ideally level 2 in both). Trainees will also need at least a level 3 qualification in the subject they intend to teach. They will also need to have a minimum of 100 hours of teaching over the life of the course. There is a requirement to evidence working with groups of learners to achieve this qualification though it may be paid or voluntary. The trainee will also need a mentor who has experience in teaching their specialist subject. Trainees should not have a criminal background which might prevent them from working as a teacher with young people or vulnerable adults.

Blended version with monthly teaching sessions of six hours with additional online content and carried out over two years

METHODS OF ASSESSMENT

The course will be assessed by written assignments and a portfolio. The trainee will have eight assessed observations of their teaching. Two assessed observations will be carried out by the subject specific mentor.

PROGRESSION

On successful completion of this course, students can progress onto a masters or a specialist Diploma in Education and Training course. There is also an opportunity to apply for QTLS status once you have gained the level 5 Diploma.
