## T LEVEL IN HEALTH

### Location

Redditch and Worcester campuses

### Course Duration

2 years

### Award on successful completion

Learners could progress to an apprenticeship, higher education or (depending on the chosen occupational specialism) employment as a healthcare support worker in a health setting.

### How to apply

Application forms are on the college website, when you will then be invited to attend an interview.

### Course overview

This qualification ensures learners have the required knowledge and skills needed to progress into skilled employment or higher education.

The qualification equips learners with:-

- The core knowledge and core skills relevant to health
- Up to date occupational knowledge and skills that have continued currency amongst employers
- The necessary English, mathematics and digital skills for the area
- Competence that meets employer expectations
- Opportunities to manage and improve their own performance

### Modules

Year 1 core component including:-

- Working within the healthcare sector
- Health, safety and environmental regulations in the health and science sector
- Managing information and data within the health and science sector
- Managing personal information
- Good scientific and clinical practice
- Providing person centred care
- Health and wellbeing
- Infection prevention and control in health specific settings
- Safeguarding

Year 2 occupational specialism – pathway to be confirmed

## **Entry requirements**

Maths, English Language and science at grade 4 or above plus two other GCSE's at grade 4 or above.

## **Delivery information**

There will be a mix of theory lessons as well as practical lessons in college with 315 hours industry placement over the two years.

## **Methods of assessment**

Year 1 - 2 written exams and an Employer Set Project

Year 2 - case study assessment, practical assessments and professional discussions.
