Maths, English Language and science at grade 4 or above plus two other GCSE's at grade 4 or above.

There will be a mix of theory lessons as well as practical lessons in college with 315 hours industry placement over the two years.

Methods of assessmen

Year 1 - 2 written exams and an Employer Set Project

Year 2 - case study assessment, practical assessments and professional discussions.
