COURSE OVERVIEW

DELIVERY INFORMATION

Workshops are held fortnightly on a Thursday evening, 18.00-21.00. Due to the nature of the qualification flexible start dates are available throughout the year. In addition you are expected to commit at least one hour study per evening, a minimum of 52 hours over the duration of the course. The course is supported by online materials via our Virtual Learning Environment and may be supplemented by online delivery.

METHODS OF ASSESSMENT

One 4,000 (approximate) word assignment to be submitted after the unit.

Guidance and resources are provided in relation to completion of this.

PROGRESSION

You can study further units to complete the CMI Level 7 Certificate or Diploma in Strategic Management and Leadership Practice which is then your first step towards completing a Master's Degree in Management and Leadership or an MBA. Local providers are the University of Worcester and Birmingham City University. Successful completion can also lead to the Chartered Manager Status, further information can be obtained from the CMI website.
