Heart of Worcestershire College (HoW College) and Higher Education Worcestershire (HE Worcestershire) have created two scholarships for students making significant academic and personal progress during their studies at HoW College. Those who apply must be planning to study on a Foundation Degree or HNC/D at the College.

Eligibility

1. Students must be on one of the following programmes:
 - 19+ Access to Higher Education
 - 16-18 Vocational level three full time programme eg BTEC, T Level
2. Students must be progressing to a three-year degree programme (and having been assessed as a Home/EU student for funding purposes) at HE Worcestershire, beginning September 2026

Qualification

HE Worcestershire will provide scholarships to students who make the most progress during their time at HoW College, this includes the extent of academic progress they make from entry on their existing course of study and consideration of personal development made during that period contributing towards their final qualification grade at HoW College.

Timing

The Scholarship Programme application process will be open from March of each academic year. The deadline will be mid-June in each Academic Year.

Process

1. Eligible students must complete the scholarship application form (below) to be considered for the scholarships award.
2. All applications received will be stored by HoW College.
3. Once the grades have been awarded to all learners, HoW College will identify those eligible students progressing to HE Worcestershire.
4. Scholarship winners will receive their award in two payments following their registration and attendance at HE Worcestershire.

Criteria

Stage 1 - Scholarship recipients will be identified and awarded based on the following:

- **Academic Achievement:** Learners must achieve or exceed their academic targets during the duration of their course.

Stage 2 - Criteria requirements - If more than one applicant achieves or exceeds their targets Stage 2 criteria will be attained and reviewed in addition to Stage 1 criteria:

- **Attendance and Punctuality**

Sustained commitment to classroom attendance across their study programmes (extenuating circumstances will be acknowledged where appropriate).

- **Commitment**

Learners should demonstrate consistent effort, resilience, and a positive attitude toward their learning.

- **Engagement**

Consideration will also be given to learners who actively engage in college culture and engage positively within the learning community (this can be evidenced from both independent interactions with a college peer and/ or group interactions within the college community).

If there is a tie after of both Stage 1 and Stage 2 criteria have been utilised, the tied application, and criteria evidence from Stages 1 and 2 shall be decided by representatives from the College's Executive Leadership Team for selection.

Who can apply

1. Any Level 3 HoW College student who is studying on either an:
 - a. 19+ Access to HE programme, or
 - b. 16-18 Vocational level three full time programme.
2. Applicants must be Home/EU students (for funding purposes).
3. Applicants must be progressing to a Foundation Degree or HNC/D programme at HE Worcestershire, beginning September of each academic year.

Awards

The two applicants considered to have made the most significant progress during their time at HoW College will be awarded the £1000 scholarship.

Should there be a tie in terms of progress, the application form will be used to determine the winners. There is no appeal process for this award, all decisions are final.
